Managing Research Relationships Professor Michele Willson

Doing research necessarily involves building, negotiating and managing relationships. Whether you are working with a supervisor, a research team, with the work of others or with organisations on the way to getting published, you will encounter a range of challenges, questions and issues that require the development of skills sets, the navigation of contentious issues and dealing with differences in power and hierarchy. This session will consider some of the issues that can arise (including authorship and attribution, power imbalances, institutional requirements) and workshop approaches to addressing or circumventing them.
